6th Grade

Course Description:

Students will focus on the Church's Creed, Liturgy and Sacraments, Christian Morality, and Prayer. We will be using the sixth grade book from the Be My Disciples series from RCL Benziger.

Format:

In addition to the reading and studying of their Religion book, students will continue to develop their faith through prayer, Bible readings and reflections, meditation, music, art projects, internet activities and working with our friends in 3A and 3B.

Expectations:

Students are expected to...

1. Come to class prepared and on time with their religion book, notebook, journal, pen, crayons/colored pencils, assignment book and the desire to learn
2. Be respectful of their faith, themselves, classmates and teacher
3. Never deface the inside or outside of their religion book or the Bible used in class
4. Be responsible for getting and making up missed work when absent
5. Follow classroom rules
6. Write down and complete homework and projects on time
