Music Syllabus – Grade 3

Students in the 3rd grade Music classes will learn about Music Notation and Musical Instruments in 32 lessons (or more - if time allows,) given weekly by the music teacher. A copy of each lesson will be left with the homeroom teacher.

Students are required to provide their own folder marked “Music” with the student’s name written in the top right corner of the folder. All lessons and extra handouts should be kept in the Music Folder. Each lesson will be read, explained and performed in class.

There will be a separate student assignment after every 5th lesson. There will also be a written test after every 10th lesson. All writing must be done with an erasable pencil, unless specified otherwise.

Homework and tests will be graded based on a 100 points scale. Please refer to the Student Handbook for information regarding the grading system of St. Jude’s School. The information regarding student conduct and the consequences for not following the school’s rules and regulations are also included there. They will be enforced during the music course at all times.

“Music Money” for Effort and Conduct will be given to students who attentively listen to music (recorded or performed live,) sing, play a musical instrument, or participate in extra-curricular music activities such as 1st Friday Liturgy, Christmas Program, and other. “Music Money” will be collected after every two quarters and applied towards the overall grade report.

Students are encouraged to share their ideas and experiences with classmates and the community, after consulting with the teacher for approval. That may include singing their favorite song, bringing their favorite music instrument, presenting a music CD, video, music book, etc.
